“Lord, make us instruments of your peace.” This is the first line of the prayer attributed to one of the most beloved saints in Church history, St. Francis of Assisi. The Feast Day of St. Francis, also known as the *Transitus*, is celebrated each year on October 4. To celebrate Francis, best known for his love of all God’s creatures, we will host our annual Blessing of the Animals service on Sunday, October 6, during the 8 a.m. service, we will hear about Francis. Animal blessings will take place only at 10:15 a.m. This is to ensure that those who do not wish to attend a service with animals present are able to do so. Bring your best furry (or feathered or scaly) friends for a blessing. Although it likely goes without saying, please do not bring animals if they happen to be aggressive or otherwise anxious around other people or animals. We look forward to celebrating the life of Francis, and our beloved pets.
