Please initial next to the following rules indicating your agreement to abide by them.
Vendor does not hold St. John's Farmers' Market (or the Episcopal
Church of St. John the Baptist) responsible for any lost, stolen or
damaged items.
Donations are requested to be received by cash or check before setup
begins.
Vendors may begin setup at 7 a.m. (one hour before opening at 8 a.m.)
Teardown equipment must not be brought to a site prior to 2 p.m.
All vehicles, hand trucks, and carts must be cleared from the vending
area by 7:30a.m.
Each booth occupant is responsible for maintaining a clean, safe
space. Vendors are responsible for the disposal of all garbage at the
end of the day. A dumpster is available on campus.
Vendors must park in designated vendor parking spaces located on the
east side of the church building.
Vendors are expected to behave appropriately.
Vendors agree to supply any needed tables, chairs, tents, and shades.
These must be secured by weights, as there is no place to install stakes
or pegs in the ground.

St. John's Farmers' Market does not supply any electrical hookups.
Restrooms are available. They must not be used for washing of dishes
or produce. Vendors agree to respect restroom tidiness.
Commercial kitchen facilities are not available on campus.
Vendors agree to closely supervise children and pets at all times.
St. John's Farmers' Market does not offer physical labor assistance to
vendors.
This is a drug-free, tobacco-free campus.
No weapons are allowed on campus.
Any music must be played at a reasonable volume. The volume must be lowered upon request.
As our campus is a Christian church, all products, labels, text, images,
and signage must be in good taste and appropriate for families.
Booth locations may change from week to week. Booth locations may
be requested, and an effort will be made to honor requests whenever possible.
Vendors are responsible for maintaining their own compliance with the
Health Department, the IRS, insurance companies, and any local and state tax entities.
Violations of this agreement or any disorderly conduct will not be tolerated. Violators may be asked to leave immediately.
I have read the terms and conditions, and I agree to abide by them. St.
John's Farmers' Market reserves the right to deny vendors from future events if they have a history of violating terms and conditions. If a vendor is asked to leave, teardown must not be disruptive.
